

- The data presented for 2025 covers January 1st through October 31st. 2023 and 2024 follow the calendar year of January 1st through December 31st.
- Per NIBRS: Offenses are counted by the number of Offenses committed per Victim in a crime and uses the Start Date (when the crime occurred) and not the Report Date (when the crime was reported) as the time period reference.



Incidents with a Written Case Report by Neighborhood






- This chart shows the selected NIBRS offenses by neighborhood.

- The data came from Accurint's VCC, which determines neighborhoods by recognized associations.


RCPD Response Time





- The Average Response
 Time of the RCPD
 improved each year for
 both the Total Calls and
 those calls designated as
 Priority, which require an
 urgent police response.
- The average time for a call being dispatched to an RCPD officer arriving on scene improved from 9.2 minutes in 2023 to 8.6 minutes in 2025.
- For Priority, Urgent Calls the Average Response Time Improved from 4.5 minutes in 2023 to 4.6 minutes in 2025.

Calls within Rockville



- In 2025 and 2024, the RCPD has responded to 83% of all Calls within Rockville, which is 13% more than in 2023.
- In addition, the Call Volume handled by the RCPD increased 49% from 2023 to 2024, and has continued this trajectory in 2025.

RCPD Traffic Enforcement Actions






- The RCPD Traffic

 of the Traffic

 increase from 77%
 in 2023.
